RULES FOR MIXED GENDER EVENT:

These are the terms and conditions on which we supply services to you. Please read and make all the members in your team aware of these terms carefully before you attend our competitions.

1.GAMES

- 1.1. In mixed pools, games are played to 13mins/1 set, with 1 margin.
- 1.2.All teams are expected to provide a 1st ref, 2nd ref and a scorer as allocated in the timetable and be sharp on time for each game.
- 1.3. Winner team takes the scoresheet to admin.
- 1.4.Communication to the referees and the management has to be via the team captains at all times.
- 1.5. For mixed pools, it is minimum of 3 ladies on court at all times excluding the libero. Usual FIVB rules apply.
- 1.6.Refusal to show up on time for matches and refereeing duties will cause loss of points as a form of penalty.
- 1.7. The games has to be played either completely socially where everyone plays every position and rotate clock-wise or if you prefer to play positions, FIVB rules have to be followed.

- 1.8. It is automatically presumed that the member who has registered the team is the captain of the team, unless otherwise stated prior to the competition, <u>not</u> during the competition.
- 1.9. Each team is liable to look after the borrowed game ball at all times till they return it back. Should there be any damage and/or change to the ball the team has to pay the full fee of the ball.

2. AT THE VENUE

- 2.1. The management reserves the right to refuse team members admission to the venue in reasonable circumstances, which include health and safety, environmental or security concerns
- 2.2. The management also reserves the right to request registered team/team members to leave the venue at any point on reasonable grounds and may take any appropriate action to enforce this right without refund.
- 2.3. You must comply with the instructions and directions given by Little Giants competitions staff and management members.
- 2.4. The use of the cameras, recording equipments are not permitted at the venue.
- 2.5. No medal to be given out before the end of the competition.

- 2.6. Should you have any questions during the tournament, speak to the referee if during the game or the organisers when off the court. Any aggressive behaviour will result in being asked to leave the venue.
- 2.7. Any argument between teams will not be tolerated and will cause loss of one game to both for delaying the tournament regardless of the subject. Both teams will be removed from the venue in more severe cases and will not be included in our future competitions.
- 2.8. We are not liable for any loss, theft or damage of your personal belongings. Please carefully check your belongings at the end of the competition.
- 2.9. Smoking is not permitted anywhere in the venue. The use of e- cigarettes is permitted only outside of the venue. Use of any illegal substances is strictly not permitted in or outside of the venue at all times.

3. REFUNDS AND CANCELLATIONS

3.1 Tickets may only be exchanged or refunded in the case of a cancelled competition. However, refunds are not given for cancellations by the team or abandonment of a competition as a result of team members have not showed up.

3.2 Our competitions are run with central music system on playing the organisation's official playlist on Spotify. The music will be set at a suitable volume and will not be turned off, up or down. Neither we will be accepting any 'special track' requests.
